

# Introduction

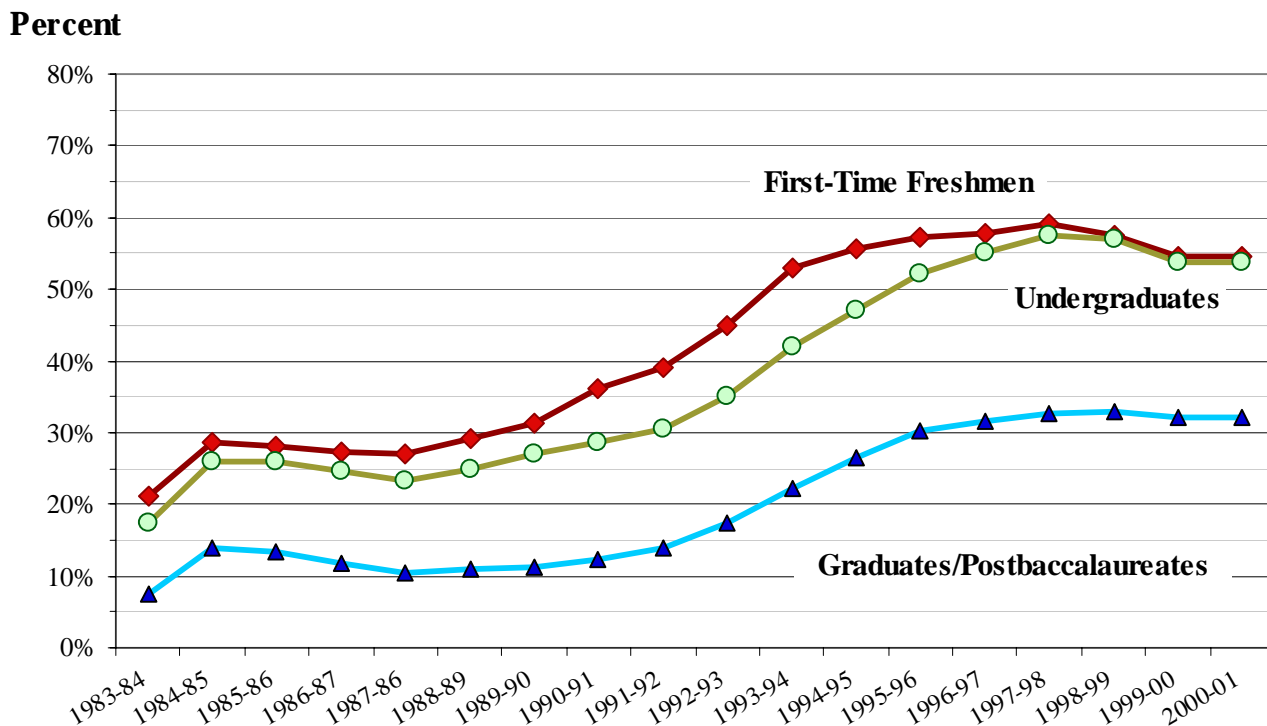
During 2000-2001, 184,625 students attending the California State University received in excess of \$1.1 billion in student financial aid funds. Financial aid recipients represented approximately 49 percent of the CSU 2000-2001 college year headcount enrollment. The percentage of CSU students receiving some form of financial aid has remained fairly constant in recent years as reflected on the chart below.

Student aid funds in the form of scholarships and grants, work-study employment, and loans are made available from a variety of sources including the federal government, state programs, CSU and campus programs, and various outside agencies and groups. The largest state financial aid program for CSU students is the State University Grant (SUG) program, which was implemented in 1982-1983 to offset the

impact of student fee increases on financially needy students. During 2000-2001, 97,685 students (about 53 percent of all CSU aid recipients) received State University Grant funds totaling over \$120 million.

The largest source of financial aid for CSU students is the federal government through its Title IV student aid programs. These programs include Federal Pell Grants for undergraduates and teacher credential students, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG) for undergraduates, Federal Work-Study, Federal Perkins Loans, and the various components of the Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) and Federal Direct Student Loan (FDSL) Programs: Stafford Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans and Parent Loans.

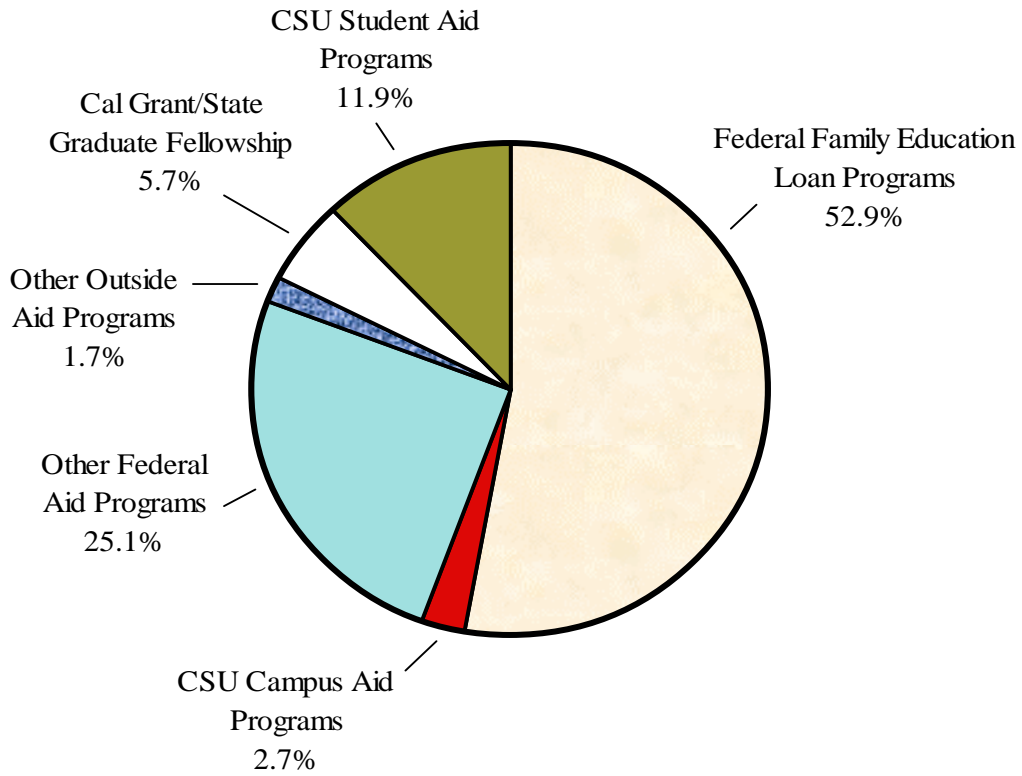
**Figure 12**

**By Type**

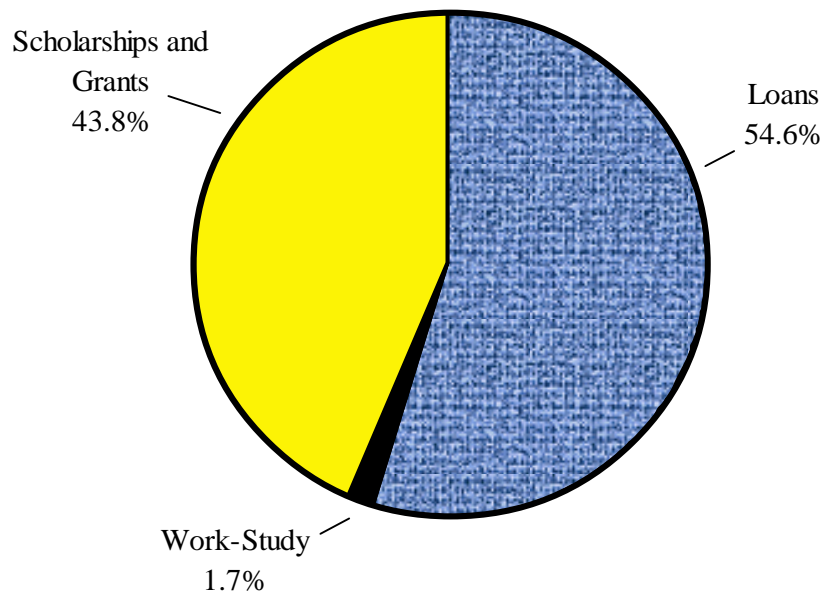
