

## Introduction

In 1970, the legislature enacted a provision that became Section 89704 of the Education Code that created the CSU Continuing Education Revenue Fund (CERF). In 1998, the legislature modified the provisions of the Education Code that permitted campuses to use either the campus Trust Accounts or CERF to manage Continuing Education Funds. At the present time, about two-thirds of the campuses use the campus Trust Account to manage their Continuing Education revenues and expenditures.

The two funds, CERF and Trust, serve as the fiscal vehicle for all self-supporting CSU instructional programs for academic credit, such as Summer Sessions, January Sessions (Winter), Special Session Degree Programs, Special Sessions, Extension, and Open University (Concurrent Enrollment). In addition, most campuses offer noncredit programs, many providing Continuing Education Units upon completion of the course.

### **Summer Sessions**

The CSU is currently replacing the former self-support Summer Sessions with a state-support program. While under study for a couple of years, it is scheduled to be implemented for some campuses for summer 2001 and the remaining campuses for summer 2002. Credit earned during the summer session is fully applicable toward all degree programs and credentials and earns credit toward meeting the university's residence requirement.

### **Special Session Degrees**

In 1996-1997 the former External Degree Program, as authorized by Title V, was replaced with a Special Session Degree Program that contained all the flexibility of the External Degree Program but made the degree part of the regular university degree offerings. Special Session Degrees may be existing campus degrees or may be special degrees approved by the campus designed to meet a special need of a professional group served by the campus.

### **January (Winter) Session**

This program is identical to Summer Session but continues to be offered as a self-support program on many CSU campuses. It is offered during the semester break between the fall and spring semesters.

### **Other Special Sessions**

This section refers to degree or other programs that are included in the campus's Academic Master Plan as state-supported programs and are offered by Continuing Education to adults, either matriculated or nonmatriculated, within the campus service community.

### **Extension Courses**

Extension courses have special limits on the credit that can be applied toward a degree. Extension courses do not meet university residence requirements.

### **Open University (Concurrent Enrollment)**

The Open University program permits community residents to enroll as nonmatriculated students in regular university courses on a space available basis. Students pay self-support fees and earn special session credit.

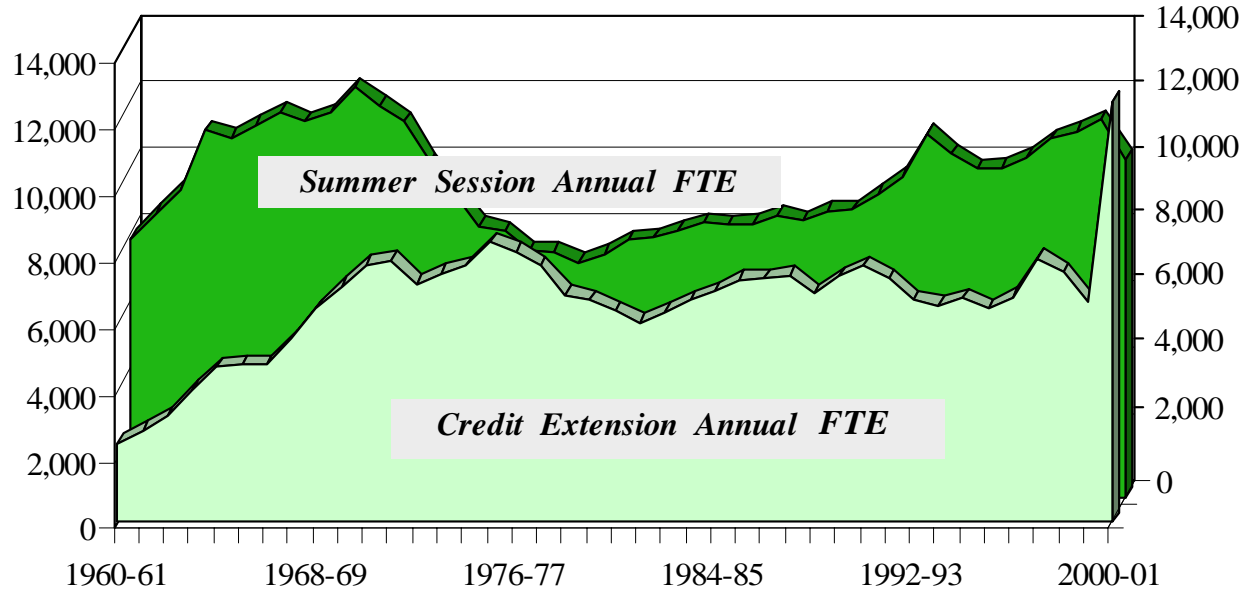
### **Noncredit Courses**

Courses in this area are divided into noncredit courses for which no official campus record is maintained and noncredit courses providing Continuing Education Units (CEUs) that are kept on a permanent record and used to verify participation to school districts, license boards, and other groups.

### **Highlights:**

- There were 22,799 annual full-time equivalent students during the 2000-2001 college year.
- Regular summer full-time equivalent students numbered 10,149 during the 2000 summer session.
- There were 58,233 course sections offered by Continuing Education during the 2000-2001 academic year.
- The 61,474 students who registered for Continuing Education Units in 2000-2001 earned 106,769 CEUs.
- The combined Continuing Education Revenue Fund (CERF) and Trust income for Continuing Education was \$129,945,627 for 2000-2001.
