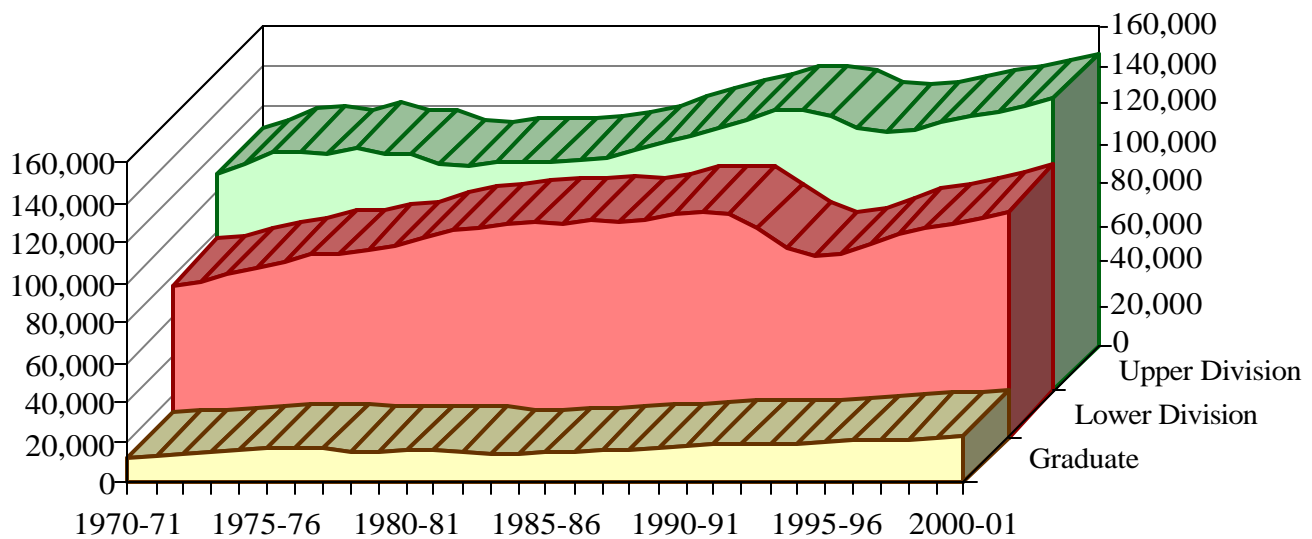
# Introduction

This section presents information on full-time equivalent student (FTES) enrollment for the Academic Year and College Year by campus and level of instruction in the California State University.

Some of the tables report FTES by lower, upper, and graduate division of instruction and by field of study. Here, the focus is on systemwide totals. A few tables

provide information for campuses by discipline division and level of instruction for the Academic Year. Full-time equivalent faculty (FTEF) information for the Academic Year, by discipline division and level of instruction, also is displayed for each campus. Finally, comparisons of budgeted and reported student faculty ratios are shown for CSU campuses.
