SUBJECT: State-Support Mode for CSU Independent Doctoral Degree Programs

This coded memorandum provides clarification that is consistent with legislative authorization, legislative intent and California State University (CSU) advocacy. CSU authority to offer independent doctoral degree programs, as authorized in California Education Code and Title 5 of the Code of California Regulations, shall be offered through state-support mode exclusively.
