

Subject: Executive Order No. 749 authorizing California State University, Long Beach to establish a Course Fee for English 498

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 749, which authorizes California State University, Long Beach to establish a Category III course fee for English 498, Louisiana Literature New Orleans Tour offered through University College and Extension Services.

In accordance with the fee policy of the California State University, each campus is required to report to the chancellor for the most recently completed fiscal year a complete inventory of all fee levels charged to students and the total revenue collected for each fee. With regard to reporting of extension course fees, overall campus extension course fees levels charged and combined total revenue should be reported jointly in the annual fee report.

Further, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing executive orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all executive orders.


Title: Category III, Course Fee for English 498

Effective Date: Winter Term 2001

Supersedes: No prior executive order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective winter term 2001, California State University, Long Beach is authorized to establish a Category III course fee for English 498 Louisiana Literature New Orleans Tour offered through University College and Extension Services. This extension course fee will range from \$895 to \$1,025 to cover costs such as transportation, hotel, tours, and meals. As a continuing education revenue fund fee under Education Code Section 89704, the revenues from this fee may be deposited either in the State University Continuing Education Revenue Fund in the State Treasury or in a local trust account as authorized in Education Code Section 89721(i).
