



## Sanitarian II

### **OVERVIEW:**

Under general direction, the Sanitarian II plans and provides sanitation services designed to protect the campus community from environmental hazards to health and safety. Incumbents are responsible for evaluation of existing situations, determination of hazardous areas, correction of existing defects, and institution of a preventive surveillance program.

### **TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:**

Incumbents in this classification plan and perform surveys, investigations, and inspections to determine environmental sanitation problems and needs of the campus; secure compliance with sanitation laws and regulations and conformance with good public health sanitation practice; inspect food handling and processing, swimming pools, housing, water supply systems, sewage disposal systems, and garbage disposal facilities for compliance with sanitation laws and regulations; investigate complaints and other indications of such nuisances as insect problems, animal bites, unsanitary waste disposal and related problems, and obtain facts, evidence and samples and recommend abatement and control measures; interpret sanitation laws and regulations to the campus officials and advise on methods of meeting and maintaining sanitary requirements; work to secure voluntary compliance on the part of the faculty, staff and students; and work with community agencies in the promotion of improved sanitation and health standards.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

#### ***Knowledge and Abilities:***

Thorough knowledge of approved sanitation principles and practices including those involved in food handling and processing, water supply, waste disposal and general sanitation. General knowledge of State laws and regulations governing public health sanitation.

Ability to carry out an effective local sanitation program; interpret environmental health and safety needs to others; interpret and apply various regulations and laws; motivate and persuade staff, faculty, students and the public to cooperate in compliance with regulations; and read and write at a level appropriate to the assigned responsibility.

#### ***Experience:***

One year of experience making sanitary inspections and obtaining compliance with established laws and regulations.

#### ***Special Qualifications:***

Possession of a valid certificate of registration as a sanitarian issued by the State of California.
