

Subject: **New Classification and Qualification Standards for Public Affairs/
Media/Arts and Public Safety-Related Classifications**

HR letter 2000-16, issued October 30, 2000, distributed the new classification and qualification standards for the Public Affairs, Media and Arts, and Public Safety Support classifications within California State Employees' Association (CSEA). Technical letter HR/SA 2000-21 provided campuses the implementation instructions. Since the distribution of these initial documents, the monthly range maximum for the Media Production Specialist (0810), Level 1, was increased to \$4,000. Attached is the revised Implementation Road Map (Attachment A) that includes this adjusted salary range.
