Subject: CSU Salary Schedule Changes – Payscale Modifications

E99 – EXCLUDED

Pursuant to HR 2002-22, the following new classification was added to the CSU paycales effective July 31, 2002:

<u>Class Code</u>	<u>Classification Title</u>
2351	Research Fellow

Effective July 31, 2002, the following classification was added to the CSU paycales to effect 403(b) deductions to employees in non-rostered appointments. Chancellor Office authorization is required prior to use.

<u>Class Code</u>	<u>Classification Title</u>
2336	Excluded 403(b) Deduction - Monthly

C.S.E.A. UNITS 2, 5, 7, and 9

The CSU paycales were modified to denote shift differential eligibility (from “N” to “Y”) pursuant to Article 20 of the Memorandum of Understanding. All classifications with a FLSA designation of “N” have shift differential eligibility.

R03 - FACULTY

Effective July 31, 2002, the following classification was added to the CSU paycales to effect 403(b) deductions to employees in non-rostered appointments. Chancellor Office authorization is required prior to use.

R06 – SKILLED TRADES

Pursuant to Technical Letter HR/Salary 2002-18, the CSU paycales were modified to reflect a 1.91% increase to the salary range minimums and maximums of all bargaining unit classifications effective July 1, 2002. An additional 1% (for a total of 2.91%) was applied to the salary range minimums and maximums of Salary Group 5 and 6 classifications effective July 1, 2002.
