Subject: Benefits Update – Dependent Fee Waiver - APC Employees (Unit 4)

The California State University (CSU) and the Academic Professionals of California (APC-Unit 4) reached agreement on benefit changes for 2002/03.

Dependent Fee Waiver

Employees eligible for the CSU fee waiver program may transfer their existing fee waiver benefit entitlement maximum to a spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner. This benefit is subject to the following conditions:

- the courses are taken by a spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner who is matriculated toward a degree and the courses are for credit toward the degree's requirements,
- this fee waiver benefit does not apply to out-of-state tuition, and
- the administration determines that there is space available in such course offerings for the spouse or dependent child.

Eligibility for this program commences with the beginning of Fall Term 2002, and participation by an eligible employee's spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner is subject to each CSU campus' standard admission and registration policies and procedures. Eligibility criteria for domestic partners shall be those used to determine such eligibility for health benefits (the Secretary of State designation of domestic partnership process). Please refer to HR/Benefits 2002-02 for the list of fees eligible for waiver.
