

Unit 4 – ACADEMIC PROFESSIONALS OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement, the payscales were modified to reflect an approximate 2.5% increase to the salary range minimums and an approximate 5% increase to the salary range maximums of Unit 4 classifications effective July 1, 2006.

Unit 8 – STATE UNIVERSITY POLICE ASSOCIATION

Pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement, the payscales were modified to incorporate an approximate 7.4% increase to the salary range minimums and maximums effective July 1, 2005, and to reflect an approximate 8% increase to the salary range minimums and maximums for Unit 8 classifications effective July 1, 2006.
