Chico: Impacted in Nursing and Recording Arts in Music.
Dominguez Hills: Impacted programs in audio recording (option in digital media arts), health science/orthotics and prosthetics option; and clinical sciences option in cytotechnology and medical technology.
Fresno: Sports Medicine/Athletic Training option impacted.
Fullerton: Impacted at the first-time freshman class level and pre-nursing, except for engineering and computer science.
Long Beach: Impacted at the first-time freshman class level. Impacted programs in Art (Option in Studio Art) and Fine Arts. Also impacted are programs in business administration (all majors), criminal justice, film and electronic arts, nursing, psychology, social work, and health science: radiation therapy technology, kinesiology (option in athletic training and option in kinesiotherapy).
Northridge: The CSUN degrees in Accountancy and Finance as well as the Financial Services option are impacted. Other programs in Business Administration are not impacted.
Pomona: Impacted in Architecture and first-time freshmen.
San Diego: Impacted at the first-time freshman class level and at the upper-division transfer level. Impacted programs in some majors, concentrations, or emphasis. (Contact campus for more information.)
San Luis Obispo: All majors are impacted. Please contact San Luis Obispo for details.
San Marcos: Impacted for business and nursing.
Sonoma: Impacted for Liberal Studies (first-time freshmen only), criminal justice and nursing.
