Subject: Federal Title II Allocation for the CSU Subject Matter Study

We are pleased to announce the availability of Federal Title II funds in support of campus-based activities associated with the CSU Subject Matter Study that was completed during the 2001-02 academic year. We appreciate your patience with the delay in receiving these funds. With virtually all of the campus data submitted, a summary and analysis of this data is being prepared by Dr. Ken Futernick, a professor of education at CSU, Sacramento. We expect the final CSU Subject Matter Study report to be available within the next two months.

Our original plan was to provide each campus with \$8,388 in support of this study. A recent review of the overall CSU Subject Matter Study budget has resulted in the identification of additional funds that are available for distribution to the campuses. Thus, the allocation for each campus is being increased to a total of \$15,000. We hope that the funds will be useful in supporting faculty efforts to reform subject matter coursework in relation to the content specifications as outlined in the *Standards of Program Quality and Effectiveness for the Subject Matter Requirement for the Multiple Subject Teaching Credential*.
