Subject: **Application Fee Waivers for California Community College EOPS Students**

In accordance with Education Code Section 69656, EOPS students from California Community Colleges (CCC) are eligible for admission application fee waivers. The California Community Colleges document these waivers by completing a signed form that is attached to admission applications sent by students to the California State University campuses. With the advent of web-based applications for admission as well as web-based applications for admission fee waivers, the CSU is simplifying the EOPS admission application fee waiver process.

Effective with the admission cycle for Fall 2007, **currently-enrolled** EOPS participation will be added to the criteria by which CSU application fee waivers may be granted to applicants for transfer admission to CSU campuses. EOPS “check offs” will be added to both the paper and web-based versions of the CSU undergraduate applications for admission. **Currently-enrolled** EOPS students will be permitted to identify themselves by checking the appropriate box on the paper or electronic admission application. These students should also provide information about the size of their family and income.

Enrolled CSU students who have received EOPS-based application fee waivers may be asked to provide written documentation of EOPS participation, e.g. California Community College forms signed by EOPS directors. Failure to provide any documentation requested by the campus and failure to meet the CSU application fee waiver threshold will require the campus to charge the CSU application fee.
