

**Subject:** **Update to Attachment 1 Designated CSU Health Care Components - Executive Order No. 877**

California State University Executive Order No. 877, *Designation of Health Care Components for Purposes of the Health Care Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA)* requires each campus to comply with the HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules and designation or de-designation as CSU Health Care Components. Effective November 1, 2011, the following meet the designation as a “health care component” and comply with HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules, as amended by the The Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health (HITECH) Act (Title XIII, Subtitle D of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act):

- California Polytechnic State University, Pomona Health Center, a covered health care provider
- California State University, Chico, Student Health Service, a covered health care provider
- California State University, Fullerton Student Health & Counseling Center, a covered health care provider
- California State University, East Bay, Student Health Services, a covered health care provider
