SUBJECT: Revisions to Executive Order 1099, Self-Support Programs and Courses

In order to address a recommendation from the 2013 California State Audit of Extended Education, the California State University must issue guidance regarding the definition of “supplant” as clarified by the state legislature and signed into law by the governor in September 2015. Therefore, we are proposing revisions to Executive Order 1099 (EO 1099), Self-Support Programs and Courses, to include the supplant definition and provide clarification on other extended education matters.
