LOWER-DIVISION TRANSFER PATTERN California State University (CSU) Statewide Pattern

The Statewide LDTP for nursing does not include the completion of General Education Requirements for the CSU, either CSU Breadth or IGETC, and does not include the completion of the statutory requirements in United States History, Constitution and American Ideals. Because of the nature of the nursing programs, an LDTP of only 29 units is presented. There are no additional local requirements. Students should expect to transfer to a particular CSU after these 29 units are completed.

Please note that the information here is an academic and curricular advising tool: a roadmap that enables transfer students to efficiently and effectively progress towards the CSU baccalaureate degree in a specified discipline. California Community College students should work closely with their advisers when planning their academic program in preparation for transfer to the CSU.
