Subject: Final Campus State University Grant Allocations

The 2004/05 Final Budget allocations (B 04-04) transmitted to campuses on August 3, 2004, included an interim allocation of State University Grant (SUG) dollars pending further review and analysis of 2003/04 financial aid data that campuses provided to the Chancellor's Office. The memorandum stated that campus financial aid offices were requested, under separate cover, to confirm the data they submitted to ensure there were no reporting errors that would inappropriately impact the distribution of SUG funding prior to the final allocation of SUG funds for 2004/05. Campuses were also advised, pending completion of this review and the release of final 2004/05 SUG allocations, to limit their scheduled expenditures to 108 percent of their 2003/04 allocation if they received interim final allocations in B 04-04 that exceeded their 2003/04 allocation.

Following completion of the review process, the changes in allocations from B 04-04 are shown on the table on page 2 of this memorandum. The final SUG allocations for fiscal year 2004/05 have been detailed on Attachment A. In total, \$209.3 million has been allocated to campuses and one hundred percent of this allocation is available for expenditure. There have been several significant adjustments from the B 04-04 interim allocations, and campuses are advised to review the final allocations carefully prior to making final 2004/05 award decisions.

The net change in 2004/05 Final State University Grant allocations is shown on the following table. These adjustments reflect the difference between the interim allocation made in B 04-04 and the 2004/05 final allocations. These adjustments are based on campus confirmation and final review of 2003/04 campus reported financial aid data. The adjustments are shown on the table below.
