Subject: California State University Employees' Union (CSUEU) Fiscal Year 2007/08
.25 Percent In-Range Progression Increase Distribution by Campus

Chancellor Reed approved an agreement with the CSUEU concerning fiscal year 2007/08 In-Range Progression (IRP) increases. Systemwide funds available for CSUEU 2007/08 salary increases were included within the 2007/08 final budget allocations. The attached table provides the CSUEU 2007/08 .25 percent In-Range Progression (IRP) increase distribution by campus. The distribution is based on the campus pro-rata share of CSUEU past-year actual salaries, which correlates with the distribution of 2007/08 compensation increases in the 2007/08 Final Budget Allocation Memo B 07-02 (reference memo at http://www.calstate.edu/budget/2007_08BudIndex/07_08BudInfo.shtml). The amounts shown in the table represent salary increases only. Employer-paid salary-related benefits costs (retirement, OASDI and Medicare) should be added to the salary amount.
