

The CSU Summer Art Program

California State University **Summer Arts** began in 1986 as a dance program housed on the campus of CSU Long Beach. The program moved to Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, then Humboldt State, then CSU Long Beach again, and most recently, CSU Fresno.

CSU Summer Arts is a multidisciplinary system-wide program offering academic credit plus a festival in the visual, performing, and literary arts.

The academic component offers two-week residency courses for undergraduates, graduates, and professionals in creative writing, dance, music, film, video, theatre, performance, visual arts, design, arts education, and new technology.

Students from throughout the California State University system, as well as from other colleges and universities throughout the nation, are encouraged to apply, as are practicing teachers, arts professionals, and serious amateurs in various arts areas. Scholarships are available to those who qualify. All courses are coordinated by members of the CSU faculty and are taught by guest artists at the top of their fields.
