²On September 22, 2005, the Governor signed SB 724 into law, which for the first time allowed the CSU to offer an independent doctoral degree. This Educational Doctoral degree (Ed.D.) program is now available and eligible employees and their eligible dependents may access the degree program through the CSU Employee Fee Waiver program." Since there is no distinction between part and full-time SUF for the Ed.D., the Ed.D. SUF is fully waived; other mandatory fees are waived as applicable for eligible employee groups per collective bargaining agreements.

³Applies to fees that must be paid to apply to, enroll in, or attend the university

⁴Actual fee waiver programs vary by collective bargaining unit (e.g. Unit 1 dependents SBA fee is \$1) / verify fee waiver program parameters with appropriate collective bargaining agreement and most current HR-Technical Letter.

⁵Students enrolled as a graduate student and employed by a state university less than full time but at least twenty hours per week, (Education Code Section 89707); Per California Admin. Code Title 5, s 41910, "A student who is a full-time employee of the Trustees or any of state agency or a student who is a child or spouse of a full-time employee of the Trustees or of any state agency shall be entitled to classification as a resident for tuition purposes until he or she has resided in California the minimum time necessary to become a resident. This section does not apply to student assistants OR employees who work all year on a part-time basis, for full-time on a less than annual basis."

⁶The number of Non-resident undergraduate waivers granted under this section at a campus shall not exceed 7.5% of undergraduate students at a campus who are citizens and residents of foreign countries. And, the number of Non-resident graduate waivers granted under this section at a campus shall not exceed 25% of graduate students at a campus who are citizens and residents of foreign countries.

Notes:

i. Waiver for Congressional Medal Of Honor recipients or their children (income cannot exceed poverty level) AB 1965, July 2002, Ed Code Section 66025.3 - required waiver

ii. Non-resident tuition waiver for active military, Ed Code Section 68075; also, certain provisions of the Higher Education Opportunity Act (P.L. 110-315) require that states provide in-state college tuition rates for armed forces members on active duty, as well as their their spouses and dependent children, for so long as any of them are continuously enrolled.

iii. Required Health Services Fees may be waived in exceptional circumstances (reference: Health Services Policy - EO 943 & BOT Standing Orders, Sections 1 and 2 of Chapter III)
