



Leave Without Pay Following a Leave With Pay
Executive Order No. 50

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to Section 43005, subdivision (c) of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code.

Each California State College President is, by this Executive Order, designated and authorized to grant an employee one leave of absence without pay not to exceed one year, at any time following the completion of leave of absence with pay by such employee, pursuant to Article 5 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code (commencing at Section 43000), if the President determines that the best interests of the California State Colleges will be so served.
