



Leaves of Absence Without Pay -

Executive Order No. 58

Pursuant to the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees as revised and amended on June 27, 1968, the authority given in Section 43100 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code to approve requests for leaves without pay for period of time, the length of which exceeds two years is hereby delegated to each State College President with respect to his particular State College, subject to the limitations stated in Section 43100.
