SUBJECT: Admissions - Nonresident Undergraduate

Average - Executive Order No. 90

I am pleased to send you a copy of Executive Order No. 90 stating the required minimum grade point average for non-resident undergraduate transfers to be used in applying the provisions of Section 40803.1 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code. This section was added by the Board of Trustees at its January Meeting and becomes effective on March 23, 1970.

In view of the possibility that the immediate implementation of this change in particular may result in some hardship, your attention is called to the provisions of Section 40806 which give the college authority to admit by special action.
