

This executive order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035, 89700, 89703, 90002, and 90012 and Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter II i, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consistent with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective June 5, 2007, California State University, Chico is authorized to establish the following Category III course fees at the specified fee rates:
