Executive Order No. 188

I am pleased to attach a copy of Executive Order No. 188 relating to differentiated parking fees at California State University, Chico.

At the May 1973 meeting, the Board of Trustees approved the delegation of authority to the Chancellor to set differentiated parking fees. The thrust of this Board action was directed at providing flexibility in the setting of rates with the aim of allowing the opportunity of varying rates by proximity to the campus core and possibly increasing the utilization of the parking facilities. Since the primary objective was to improve the equity of fee charges without significantly changing the campus parking revenues, the campuses would ordinarily have to charge higher rates for lots closest to the academic core and a lower rate for those furthest from the core.

We are sure that you are aware that your proposal constitutes a variance from the normal approach in that only a reduction of fee rate for outlying lots is proposed. However, we recognize that your campus does have unusual problems with regard to parking and that you have projected there should be no overall reduction in campus parking revenue.

Your request for the differential fees is being approved on a trial basis with the understanding that the authority to charge the fee will be rescinded if during the current semester the campus parking revenue falls below the rate which was expected from the uniform fee rates.

Differentiated Parking Fees  
California State University, Chico  
Executive Order No. 188

Effective immediately, the President of California State University, Chico is hereby authorized to charge a parking fee at the rate of \$8.00 per semester for parking privileges in a 765 space facility located north of the campus athletic fields. This rate is established as an addition to the current Parking Fee Schedule adopted by the Board of Trustees. All other rates set by that Schedule shall not be affected by this Executive Order. This authorization of a differential parking fee is made pursuant to subdivision 1 of Section 6 of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees of The California State University and Colleges and has been approved by the Director of General Services pursuant to Section 42201(a) of the California Administrative Code, Title 5 and Section 23751 of the Education Code.
