Rental Rates for Housing Facilities
Executive Order No. 205

A. Effective July 1, 1974, rentals on housing facilities governed by Article 5, (commencing with Section 42000) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule of rates, which include board rates, where specified.

(a) Family Dwelling Units

One-bedroom unit	
San Jose State University	60.00

These rental rates include essential furniture and utilities, except that, in any project of 100 or more family dwelling units in which there are installed individual unit electric and gas meters and the licensees pay the utility companies directly, the rental rate may be reduced by \$7.50 per month per dwelling unit.

- (1) On-campus apartments and rooms in remodeled houses are available at \$45-75 per month.
- (2) Two former Head Resident apartments are available at \$1,000 per academic year.
- (3) Meal plans available in increments from 10 to 20 meals per week.
- (4) Fifteen meal plan is three meals Monday through Friday; fourteen meal plan is two meals per day, seven days per week.
- (5) When available, a double may be rented as a single at a rate of equal to the normal double rate plus \$200.
- (6) When available, a double room may be rented as a single at a rate equal to the normal double rate plus \$300.
- (7) Meal plans are available on an optional basis. Fall semester rates range from \$215 to \$285 for 10 to 19 meals per week.
- (8) Food service is on a script basis. Students have an option of the three plans.
- (9) Meal plans are available on an optional basis. Fall quarter rates range from \$225 to \$300 for 12 to 19 meals per week.


