Attached is a copy of Executive Order No. 234 relating to differentiated parking fees at California State College, Stanislaus.

Of course, your proposal constitutes a variance from the normal approach in that only a reduction of fee rate for remote lots is proposed. However, we recognize that your campus does have unusual problems with regard to parking and that you have projected that there should be no overall reduction in campus parking revenue.

Your request for the differentiated fees is being approved on a trial basis with the understanding that the authority to charge the fees will be rescinded if during the 1976/77 fiscal year the campus parking revenue falls below the rate which was expected from the uniform fee rates.

Title: Differentiated Parking Fees, California State College, Stanislaus


Effective Date: May 14, 1976

Effective with the commencement of the summer period, 1976, the President of California State College, Stanislaus is authorized to charge parking fees for parking privileges in lots No. 2 and No. 3 on the southwest and west perimeter of the campus at the following rates:

Semester term	\$8.00
Winter term	1.50
Summer period	6.00

These rates are established as an addition to the current Parking Fee Schedule adopted by the Board of Trustees. All other rates set by that schedule shall not be affected by this Executive Order. This authorization is made pursuant to subdivision 1 of Section 6 of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees of The California State University and Colleges and has been approved by the Director of General Services pursuant to Section 42201 (a) of the California Administrative Code, Title 5 and Section 23751 of the Education Code.
