

Executive Order No. 236

Title: Nonresident Tuition

Effective Date: March 24, 1976

Pursuant to the authority vested in me to determine and specify nonresident tuition by Section 41900 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, the maximum amount to be collected for nonresident tuition per academic year commencing with the fall 1976 term is established at \$1,440.00. The fee for each term shall be collected in accordance with the following schedule:


1. All campuses other than California State College, Stanislaus:

	Quarter	Semester
15 or more units	\$480.00 (maximum)	\$720.00 (maximum)
Per unit	32.00	48.00

2. California State College, Stanislaus:

	Term
13 or more units	\$624.00 (maximum)
Per unit	48.00

This Executive Order is effective immediately.
