

Executive Order No.: 254

Title: Delegation of Authority – Establish, Increase, Decrease or Abolish Bicycle Storage Fees Not Exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10)

Effective Date: September 13, 1976


Supersedes:

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to Paragraph III, Section 6, subdivisions (i) and (m) of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees of The California State University and Colleges.

Authority is hereby delegated to each President to establish, increase, decrease, or abolish bicycle storage fees in amounts not exceeding ten dollars (\$10) for the use of campus bicycle storage facilities. *The fee may be charged of any student or other member of the public using campus bicycle storage facilities.* A copy of the schedule of fees so adopted shall be sent to the Vice Chancellor for Business Affairs.

Income from the fees collected pursuant to this Executive Order may be expended only for the cost of operation and maintenance of the facilities for which the charge is made. Maintenance cost may include provision for improvement of the storage facilities and liability insurance as necessary.

The campus fiscal office shall have the ultimate responsibility for collecting, expending, and reporting all bicycle storage fees. These fees will be deposited and expended through the State College Trust Fund. Income and expenditures will be reported in year-end closing financial statements for Trust Fund operations.
