Executive Order No.: 261
Title: Nonresident Tuition
Effective Date: July 1, 1977
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 236

Pursuant to the authority vested in me to determine and specify nonresident tuition by Section 41900 of Title 5 of the *California Administrative Code*, the maximum amount to be collected for nonresident tuition per academic year commencing with the Fall 1977 term is established at \$1,575.00. The fee for each term shall be collected in accordance with the following schedule:

1. All campuses other than California State College, Stanislaus:

	Quarter	Semester
15 or more units	\$525.00 (maximum)	\$787.50 (maximum)
Per Unit	35.00	52.50

2. California State College, Stanislaus:

	Term
13 or more units	\$682.50 (maximum)
Per Unit	52.50

This Executive Order is effective immediately.
