

Subject: Differentiated Parking Fees
San Diego State University
Executive Order No. 269

I am pleased to transmit a copy of Executive Order No. 269 relating to differentiated parking fees as requested by San Diego State University.

This action is pursuant to the unusual parking problems which currently exist on your campus, and is an attempt to increase the utilization of the parking facilities which are not of close proximity to the campus core. The campus has projected that there will be no overall reduction of campus parking revenue due to the implementation of this fee.

Your request for the differentiated fees is being approved on a trial basis with the understanding that the authority to charge the fees will be rescinded if during the 1977/78 fiscal year the campus parking revenue falls below the rate which was expected from the uniform fee.

In accordance with Chancellor's Office policy, the campus President has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.

Title: Differentiated Parking Fees
San Diego State University
Effective Date: April 29, 1977
Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order Issued

Effective with the commencement of the 1976/77 Spring semester, the President of San Diego State University is authorized to charge parking fees for parking privileges in Lot No. "C" at the following rate:

Per Semester \$10.00

This rate is established as an addition to the current Parking Fee Schedule adopted by the Board of Trustees. All other rates set by that schedule shall not be affected by this Executive Order. This authorization is made pursuant to subdivision j of Section 6 of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees of The California State University and Colleges and has been approved by the Director of General Services pursuant to Section 42201 (a) of Title 5 of the *California Administrative Code*, and Section 23751 of the Education Code.
