

Executive Order No.: 270

Title: Student Body Association Fee
California State College, San Bernardino

Effective Date: April 29, 1977

Supersedes: Executive Order No. 55, as it relates to California State College, San Bernardino, Student Body Association Fee

Effective with the commencement of the Fall Quarter, 1977, the Student Body Association Fee Schedule requested by California State College, San Bernardino is approved for implementation. The fee schedule authorized herein shall supersede all such fees previously authorized for California State College, San Bernardino. Student Body organization fees shall be collected in the amounts specified in this Order, except as waived in individual cases, pursuant to Education Code Section 23801. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, Subdivision "c" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.
