

**Executive Order No.:** 277  
**Title:** Fees for Housing Facilities  
**Effective Date:** July 1, 1977  
**Supersedes:** Executive Order No. 248

Effective July 1, 1977, license fees for housing facilities governed by Articles 5 and 6 (commencing with Section 42000) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, and Education Code Section 90012 shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule of rates.


