

I am transmitting to you five copies of Executive Order No. 293, which continues in effect Interim Disciplinary Action Procedures for Academic Personnel, established by Executive Orders Nos. 245 and 274.

These procedures are continued in effect until July 1, 1979, because consultation with the Academic Senate, CSUC, on replacement procedures is still continuing. I am informed that very substantial progress towards issuance of permanent procedures has been made, but the process is not yet completed. When it has been, and employee organizations have met and conferred on the subject, should they wish to do so, permanent procedures will be issued.
