Executive Order No.: 312
Title: Fees for Housing Facilities
Effective Date: July 30, 1979
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 297-Revised

Effective July 1, 1979 fees for housing facilities governed by Article 5 (commencing with Section 42000) and Article 6 (commencing with Section 42100) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the *California Administrative Code*, and Education Code Section 90012, shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule of rates.



\$5.00 to be charged if the required fee is not paid within 10 days of the date due.
