Executive Order No.: 321
Title: Nonresident Tuition
Effective Date: July 1, 1980
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 307

Pursuant to the authority vested in me to determine and specify nonresident tuition by Section 41900 of Title 5 of the *California Administrative Code*, the maximum amount to be collected for nonresident tuition per academic year commencing with the Fall 1980 term is established at \$2,160.00. The fee for each term shall be collected in accordance with the following schedule:


1. All campuses other than California State College, Stanislaus:

| | Quarter | Semester |
|------------------|--------------------|----------------------|
| 15 or more units | \$720.00 (maximum) | \$1,080.00 (maximum) |
| Per Unit | 48.00 | 72.00 |

2. California State College, Stanislaus

| | Term |
|------------------|--------------------|
| 13 or more units | \$936.00 (maximum) |
| Per Unit | 72.00 |
