Title: Student Body Center Fee  
Humboldt State University  
Effective Date: May 7, 1980  
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 265

Effective with the Fall Quarter, 1980, the Student Body Center Fee Schedule requested by Humboldt State University is approved for implementation. The fee schedule authorized herein shall supersede all such fees previously authorized for Humboldt State University. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, subdivision "d" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

Fees shall be charged as herein authorized, pursuant to Education Code Section 90012, subdivision (c) and Education Code Section 90068.
