Executive Order No: 331
Title: Fees for Housing Facilities
Effective Date: July 1, 1980
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 312

Effective July 1, 1980, fees for housing facilities governed by Article 5 (commencing with Section 42000) and Article 6 (commencing with 42100) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, and Education Code Section 90012, shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule of rates.
