

Title: Student Body Association Fee
 California State College, Stanislaus
Effective Date: July 23, 1981
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 55

Effective with the commencement of the Fall Quarter, 1981, the Student Body Association Fee Schedule requested by California State College, Stanislaus is approved for implementation. The fee schedule authorized herein shall supersede all such fees previously authorized for California State College, Stanislaus. Student Body organization fees shall be collected in the amounts specified in this Order, except as waived in individual cases, pursuant to Education Code Section 89300. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, Subdivision "c" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.
