**Executive Order No.:** 359  
**Title:** Fees for Housing Facilities  
**Effective Date:** August 5, 1981  
**Supersedes:** Executive Order No. 331

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to Education Code Sections 89700, 90012, and 90068 as delegated in Section 42004 of Title 5, *California Administrative Code* and Section 6-e of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

Effective July 1, 1981, fees for housing facilities governed by Article 5 (commencing with Section 42000) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the *California Administrative Code* shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule.

Data concerning meals are provided for information only. Meal rates and frequency are not set by this Executive Order. The campuses should be consulted for the most recent information concerning meals.
