

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 361 which establishes the nonresident tuition fee commencing with the Fall 1981 term.

It should be noted that there is no maximum fee per term since the total fee paid will be determined by the number of units taken per term, including those in excess of fifteen.

It is your responsibility as President to implement Executive Order No. 361 where applicable and to maintain the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.

Executive Order No.: 361  
Title: Nonresident Tuition  
Effective Date: Fall Term 1981  
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 321


Pursuant to the authority vested in me to determine and specify nonresident tuition, the amount to be collected for nonresident tuition per unit commencing with the Fall 1981 term is established for all campuses in accordance with the following schedule:

	<u>QUARTER</u>	<u>SEMESTER</u>
Charge Per Unit	\$63	\$94.50

The fee for California State College, Stanislaus will be the same as the semester unit charge, \$94.50.

The total fee paid per term will be determined by the number of units taken, including those in excess of fifteen.

This Executive Order is effective Fall Term 1981.
