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Executive Order No.: 388-Revised
Title: Fees for Housing Facilities
Effective Date: June 30, 1982
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 375

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to Education Code Sections 89700, 90012, and 90068 as delegated in Section 42004 of Title 5, California Administrative Code and Section 6-e of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

Effective July 1, 1982, fees for housing facilities governed by Article 5 (commencing with Section 42000) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code shall be charged in accordance with the following schedule.

Data concerning meals are provided for information only. Meal rates and frequency are not set by this Executive Order. The campuses should be consulted for the most recent information concerning meals.

6. **SERVICE FEE**

\$4.00 per installment payment (not including the initial prepayment) to a maximum of \$20.00 per academic year.

7. **LATE FEE**

Late fee means a payment required of a licensee who fails to pay any fee when due (Title 5, Section 42000 (j)).

\$5.00 to be charged if the required fee is not paid within 10 days of the date due.

8. **CHECK RETURNED FEE**

\$10.00 is to be charged for all checks returned, regardless of the cause.
