Executive Order No.: 397  
Title: State University Fee  
Effective Date: July 14, 1982  
Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued in response to action of the Board of Trustees in Resolution RFIN 7-82-8 which was adopted by the Board pursuant to authority in Section 89700 of the Education Code. This action is necessitated by the requirements of the Budget Act of 1982 as passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor of the State of California. In order to meet costs for services, facilities, and materials essential to the conduct of quality postsecondary education in The California State University, this action has been taken.

I. Fee Schedule

Effective with the 1982 Fall term, the State University Fee shall be collected from each regularly enrolled student in accordance with the following schedule:

1. All campuses except California State College, Stanislaus:

UNITS	PER SEMESTER	PER QUARTER	ACADEMIC YEAR
0 to 5.9	\$24	\$16	\$ 48
6.0 or more	\$75	\$50	\$150

2. California State College, Stanislaus:

UNITS	FALL & SPRING TERM	WINTER TERM	ACADEMIC YEAR
0 to 5.9	\$18	\$12	\$ 48
6.0 or more	\$69	\$12	\$150

II. Fee Administration

A. Accounting

This fee is to be collected and remitted to the State Treasurer as would any other General Fund reimbursement. The AEL account code to be used in accounting for these funds is as follows:

B. Time of Payment

The State University Fee must be paid at time of registration pursuant to the provisions of Section 89301 of the Education Code.

C. Exemptions and Fee Waivers

Listed below are those statutorily mandated fee exemptions, and those fee waiver programs which are available at the discretion of the Trustees or the Chancellor. As indicated, the fee waiver programs for senior citizens and employees will apply to this fee.

FEE WAIVER PROGRAM	AUTHORITY	ACTION
1. Children of a parent killed or disabled in military service	Education Code 32320 Title 5, Section 41801	Fee must be waived
2. Children of a parent killed in active law enforcement or fire suppression	Education Code 68121	Fee must be waived
3. Senior Citizens (Calif. residents 60 years of age or older)	Education Code 89330 Title 5, Section 40760	Fee may be waived
4. Employees (approved training and career development)	Education Code 89710 Title 5, Section 41804	Fee may be waived
5. High School students in special programs	Executive Order 314	Fee may be waived

**D. Refund**

The State University Fee shall be refunded in accordance with the normal fee refund procedures of Title 5, California Administrative Code.

**E. Change in Fee Category**

When the unit load of a student is reduced to a lower fee category, the difference between the two categories may be refunded less five dollars to cover processing costs. Said five dollar fee is established pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, Subdivision (i) of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees of The California State University.

**F. Disposition of Fee Revenues**

Revenues from the fee are "appropriated for the support of The California State University in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefore by the Legislature" (Education Code Section 89724).
