I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 415 which establishes the nonresident tuition fee commencing with the Fall 1983 term.

This Executive Order continues the policy initially established in Executive Order No. 361 that there is no maximum fee per term since the total fee paid will be determined by the number of units taken per term, including those in excess of fifteen.

It is your responsibility as President to implement Executive Order No. 415 where applicable and to maintain the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.

Title: Nonresident Tuition  
Effective Date: Fall Term 1983  
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 378


Pursuant to Section 41901 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, the amount to be collected for nonresident tuition per unit commencing with the Fall 1983 term is established for all campuses in accordance with the following schedule:

	Quarter	Semester
Charge Per Unit	\$72	\$108

The fee for California State College, Stanislaus will be the same as the semester unit charge, \$108.

The total fee paid per term will be determined by the number of units taken, including those in excess of fifteen.

This Executive Order is effective Fall Term 1983.
