Subject: Executive Order 453 Modified Eligibility Indices for Admission to CSU

Provost Vandament's memorandum to you of January 17, 1985, reported on the CPEC Eligibility Study of 1983 High School Graduates. That report disclosed that CSU's admission standards identified 29.2 percent of California public high school graduates to be eligible for regular admission. He further indicated in that memorandum that we would adjust the CSU eligibility index to ensure that we select from the upper one-third of the California public high school graduates for fall 1985 and later terms. Executive Order Number 453 (attached) establishes the revised eligibility indices to accomplish that goal.

The order restates the formulas for computing the eligibility indices using the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and American College Test (ACT) and establishes revised minimum values for determining eligibility for admission under Section 40753. It further restates the existing minimum values for Section 40754 of Title 5, which requires no changes at this time. Section 40753 pertains to applicants who are California residents or graduates of a California high school; section 40754, to applicants who are neither California residents nor graduates of a California high school.

Attached to the Executive Order are revised Eligibility Index Tables. Please note that the table for California high school graduates establishes that an applicant with a grade point average above 3.10 has a qualifiable index without reference to a test score.

Of course, the definition of the eligibility index contained in Section 40601, subdivision (f), remains unchanged.



Executive Order No.: 453
Title: Modified Eligibility Indices for Admission
Effective Date: February 22, 1985
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 24

Pursuant to Section 40601, subdivision (f), and Sections 40753 and 40754 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, the following eligibility indices are established. Although this Executive Order is effective upon its issuance, the indices established herein shall be used in making admissions decisions beginning with fall 1985 applicants.

1. The formula for computing the eligibility index using the total of the verbal and mathematics scores on the Scholastic Aptitude Test is $(800 \times \text{GPA}) + \text{SAT}$.
2. The formula for computing the eligibility index using the composite score of the American College Test is $(200 \times \text{GPA}) + (10 \times \text{ACT})$.
3. The minimum eligibility index referred to in Section 40753 is established at 2994 for the Scholastic Aptitude Test and 722 for the American College Test.
4. The minimum eligibility index referred to in Section 40754 is established at 3402 using the Scholastic Aptitude Test and 826 using the American College Test.

Tables reflecting the revised indices are attached to this Executive Order and are included as part of the Executive Order.
