Subject: Modified Eligibility Indices for Admission to CSU; Technical Adjustment — Executive Order No. 500

Executive Order No. 453, issued February 22, 1985, established revised minimum values for determining eligibility for admission under Section 40753, Title 5, which establishes the standards for freshman applicants who are California residents or graduates of a California high school. That Executive Order was determined necessary in light of the findings of the CPEC Eligibility Study of 1983 High School Graduates, published January 1985. EO 453 did not change the values for determining eligibility for admission under Section 40754 which sets the standards for freshman applicants who are neither California residents nor graduates of a California high school.

Executive Order No. 500, attached, (1) restates the formulas for computing eligibility indices, (2) restates the minimum values for determining eligibility for admission under Section 40753, and (3) makes a technical adjustment to the eligibility table used in determining admission under Section 40754.

Attached to the Executive Order are (1) the existing eligibility index table for California high school graduates, which became effective fall 1985, and (2) the revised eligibility index table for nonresidents, which becomes effective beginning with fall 1987 applicants.

The definition of the eligibility index contained in Section 40601, subdivision (f), remains unchanged.

Title: Modified Eligibility Indices for Admission; Technical Adjustment
Effective Date: October 15, 1986
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 453

Pursuant to Section 40601, subdivision (f), and Sections 40753 and 40754 of Title 5 of the California Administrative Code, the following eligibility indices are established. Although this Executive Order is effective upon its issuance, the indices established herein shall be used in making admissions decisions beginning with fall 1987 applicants.

1. The formula for computing the eligibility index using the total of the verbal and mathematics scores on the Scholastic Aptitude Test is $(800 \times \text{GPA}) + \text{SAT}$.
2. The formula for computing the eligibility index using the composite score of the American College Test is $(200 \times \text{GPA}) + (10 \times \text{ACT})$.
3. The minimum eligibility index referred to in Section 40753 is established at 2994 for the Scholastic Aptitude Test and 722 for the American College Test.
4. The minimum eligibility index referred to in Section 40754 is established at 3402 using the Scholastic Aptitude Test and 822 using the American College Test.

Tables reflecting the revised indices are attached to this Executive Order and are included as part of the Executive Order.
