Title: Fees for Housing Facilities
Effective Date: June 20, 1989
Supersedes: Executive Order No. 531

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to Education Code Sections 89700, 90012, and 90068 as delegated in Section 42004 of Title 5, California Administrative Code and Section 6-e of Chapter III of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

Effective July 1, 1989, fees for housing facilities governed by Article 5 (commencing with Section 42000) of Subchapter 5, Chapter 1, Part V, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code shall be charged in accordance with the schedule below.

Board rates and frequency of meals are not set by this Executive Order and are provided below for information only. The length of an academic year and the period covered by a housing license agreement vary according to campus schedules. The individual campuses should be contacted for the most recent information.

5. SERVICE FEE

Service fee means a non-refundable fee required of a licensee to cover the added costs incurred in collecting and processing a license fee by installments (Title 5, Section 42000 (i)).

\$4 ↔ \$10 per installment payment to a maximum of \$40 per academic year.


6. LATE FEE

Late fee means a payment required of a licensee who fails to pay any fee when due (Title 5, Section 42000 (j)).

\$10 ↔ \$50 per late payment.

7. CHECK RETURNED FEE

\$10 is to be charged for all checks returned, regardless of the cause.
