**Executive Order No.:** 558  
**Title:** Salaries for Extension and Special Session (Other Than Summer Session) Faculty  
**Effective Date:** July 1, 1990  
**Supersedes:** Executive Order No. 542

Effective July 1, 1990, salary rates for Extension and Special Session Faculty (Class Code 2363) shall be increased approximately 4.8 percent above the rates in effect for such faculty since July 1989. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 8, subdivision "j" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

The salary rates herein authorized shall be published by the Vice Chancellor for Faculty and Staff Relations. Amended salary rates for Extension and Special Session faculty conforming to approved campus plans may subsequently be issued by the Vice Chancellor for Faculty and Staff Relations.
