Subject: Nonresident Tuition Fee Level - Executive Order No. 561

I transmit to you a copy of Executive Order No. 561 which establishes the Nonresident Tuition Fee commencing with the Fall 1990 term.

The 1990/91 Budget Act contains language and dollar adjustments to increase nonresident tuition by \$500 per full-time equivalent student for the 1990/91 academic year. The Board of Trustees did not increase the nonresident tuition fee when it adopted its 1990/91 Support Budget in November, 1989 because the 1989/90 Budget Act had contained, at the Governor's request, a significant increase in the nonresident tuition fee. It had been the Trustees' intent to forego increases in the nonresident tuition fee until the fee equaled or was less than the level it would have been using the traditional nonresident tuition fee calculation methodology established by the Board in subdivision (b)(1) of Section 41901 of Title 5, California Code of Regulations. However, Section 41901 also provides that should the State budget require a fee greater than the calculated amount, the larger fee shall be implemented.

This Executive Order implements the nonresident tuition fee requirement contained in the 1990/91 Budget Act as enacted by the Legislature and signed by the Governor July 31, 1990. The fee established by Executive Order No. 561 authorizes a \$500 per year tuition increase for nonresident students, which represents a 8.8 percent increase over the 1989/90 fee level.

You will note that Executive Order No. 561 is effective immediately. Campuses have discretion to utilize the most effective method possible for collecting the increased fee. However, care should be employed so as not to create undue hardship or unreasonable financial obligations for students.

In accordance with Sections 41900 and 41901 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, the amount for Nonresident Tuition effective with the Fall 1990 term and until further amended, is established for all campuses in accordance with the following schedule:

	<u>Quarter</u>	<u>Semester</u>
Charge Per Unit	\$137	\$205

The total fee paid per term shall be determined by multiplying the number of units taken by the charge per unit in accordance with this fee schedule.
