Subject: Student Body Association Fee — Humboldt State University — Executive Order No. 606

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 606 which authorizes the establishment of a revised Student Body Association Fee Schedule requested by Humboldt State University.

The Student Body Association fee increase was approved by student referendum to support programs such as the Women's Center, Youth Educational Services, Children's Center, Student Clubs, Cultural Programming, CenterArts Special Events, Campus Recycling, Campus Center for Appropriate Technology, Drop In Recreation, Lumberjack Days, Tutoring, and many others. However, revenues from the Student Body Association fee may be used for any purpose approved by the Trustees and are subject to regular allocation and appropriation procedures applicable to the Student Body Association.

In accordance with policy of The California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.

Title: Student Body Association Fee – Humboldt State University

Effective Date: August 2, 1993

Supersedes: Executive Order No. 518

Effective with the Fall Semester 1993, the revised Student Body Association Fee Schedule requested by Humboldt State University is approved for implementation. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, subdivision "c" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees. Student Body Association fees shall be collected in the amounts specified in this Order, except as waived in individual cases, pursuant to Education Code Section 89300.

The approved schedule is as follows:
